ALEXANDER MACOMB MASON / Mason Bey / born / November 9, 1841 / died / March 17, 1897.

\*Alexander Macomb Mason was a great-grandson of George Mason of *Gunston Hall*. During the Civil War he was on naval duty and, for one year, was private secretary to James Y. Mason, Confederate commissioner to London. He served in Chile, China, and Cuba, and was recruited for the general staff of the Egyptian army.
