Ringgold / born at the Washington / Arsenal, D.C., Dec. 17, 1847 / died at *Vaucluse*, North- / hampton Co., Va., Aug. 17, 1853. / *In Heaven, their angels / do always behold the face / of my Father.* [small obelisk]

SALLY SMITH UPSHUR / Born 26 Oct. 1815 / Died 25 Dec. 1871 / aged 56 years. / *God said let there be light / and there was light.* [small obelisk] [Foot: S.S.U.]

ABEL B. UPSHUR / died Feb. 6, 1895 / aged 73 years. / C.W. UPSHUR / wife of / A.B. Upshur / born July 11, 1828 / died April 18, 1886. / *Having fought the good / fight, and kept the faith.* / UPSHUR.

Capt. THOMAS LEE / RINGGOLD, U.S.A. / son of / Tench and Mary Ringgold / born at *Coton*, Loudon [sic] Co., / Va., June 29<sup>th</sup>, 1818, died at / Washington, D.C., May 11<sup>th</sup> / 1854. / *Blessed are the dead who / die in the Lord.* [obelisk]

SUSAN BROWN / wife of / Capt. Thomas Lee / Ringgold, / daughter of / Abel Parker and Elizabeth / Ann Upshur / born at *Vaucluse*, North- / ampton Co., Va., April 12<sup>th</sup> 1826 / died in Washington, D.C. / Nov. 10<sup>th</sup> 1858. / *He giveth his beloved sleep.* [obelisk]

ABEL PARKER UPSHUR\*\* / Born 1790 / Died February 28<sup>th</sup> 1844. / ELIZABETH ANN BROWN UPSHUR / Born April 8<sup>th</sup> 1805 / Died January 17<sup>th</sup> 1874. / *It doth not yet appear what we / shall be, but we know that when HE / shall appear we shall be like HIM, / for we shall see HIM as HE is. / 1<sup>st</sup> John 3d Ch., ver. 2.* [statue of draped woman holding cross.]

MARY LEE / daughter of Thomas L. / and Susan B. Ringgold / born at *Vaucluse*, North- / ampton Co., Va., April 13<sup>th</sup> / 1851 / died in Washington, D.C. / Feb. 14<sup>th</sup> 1859. / *Jesus called a little / child unto him.* [obelisk]
