Lieut. JOSEPH BRYANT SMITH / U.S. Navy / Born December 29<sup>th</sup> 1826 / Killed in Battle While in / Command of the U.S. Frigate / *Congress* / March 8<sup>th</sup> 1862. / *He died doing his duty.*

ALBERT NATHANIEL SMITH / Commander, U.S. Navy / Born November 20<sup>th</sup> 1822 / Died September 8<sup>th</sup> 1866 / *[illegible]*.

HARRIET SMITH / born May 22<sup>nd</sup> 1797 / died September 2<sup>nd</sup> 1855. / *Requiescat in pace.*

JOSEPH SMITH / Rear Admiral, U.S.N. / born March 30<sup>th</sup> 1790 / died January 17<sup>th</sup> 1877. / *Requiescat in Pace.*

† / ANNA E. SMITH / died January 2<sup>nd</sup> 1894. / *Requiescat in pace.*
