1. ETHEL. [for Ethel Howard Wallach, bur. 21 SEP 1876]
2. LOUISA BROWN / Daughter of / Rosa & Richard Wallach / Born January 22d 1861 / Died January 16th 1862.
3. ROSE DOUGLAS / Daughter of / John Hancock and / Rose Douglas Wallach Merriam / 1910-1913.
4. ROSA BROWN / Wife of / Richard Wallach / December 16, 1838 / January 16, 1916.
5. RICHARD WALLACH* / Born April 5th 1816 / Died March 4th 1881. / *Mark the perfect man, behold the up- / right, the end of that man is Peace.*

*Richard Wallach was U.S. Marshal for the District of Columbia in 1853, when his brother bought the *Evening Star* newspaper. When the mayor of Washington was deposed and went to Richmond in 1861, Wallach was made mayor, a position that he held until 1868.
6. [fallen and broken] MARSHALL BROWN WALLACH / Born September 11, 1862 / Died August 26, 1917.
7. JESSE BROWN / 1847-1904.
8. LOUISA STUART BROWN / wife of / Marshall Brown / Born January 1, 1821 / Died October 18, 1885. / *Just as I am without a plea.*
9. MARSHALL BROWN / Born September 16th 1816 / Died December 16th 1881. / *An honest man, the noblest work of God.*
10. EDITH JAMES WALLACH / Apr. 16th 1870 / Oct. 11th 1950.
11. ROSE DOUGLAS WALLACH / MERRIAM / 1878-1947.
12. ROSANNAH / wife of Jesse Brown / Died February 2nd 1853 / aged 79 years.
13. JESSE BROWN / Died April 7th 1847 / aged 79 years.

*Jesse Brown in 1820 became the proprietor of a hotel he named the Indian Queen. His sons sold the hotel in 1863 when it was renamed the Metropolitan.
14. RICHARD WALLACH / August 14th 1867 / October 13th 1929.
