WILLIAM MARBURY* / a native of Maryland / died March 13th 1835 / aged 73 years. / ANN O. MARBURY / relict of William / died February 7th 1847 / aged 77 years. [damaged 9/04]

*Plaintiff in the famous *Marbury v. Madison* (1803) case wherein William Marbury sued Secretary of State James Madison to force him to deliver his commission as a justice of the peace.
