*** Jean Lander was an actress, and is noted for reportedly overhearing a plot to kidnap or kill President Lincoln. Her father was a British lawyer and theater manager and her mother was an actress. She was performing in California in 1855, and in 1860, when she married Frederick W. Lander in San Francisco. She had a big house where the Supreme Court now stands. She gave a fine Tiffany window to St. Mark's Church on Capitol Hill.
