HENRIETTA L. GREEN / born Feb. 23, 1831 / died Dec. 21, 1871 / daughter of the late / Lt. Col. John Green, U.S.A. / *He giveth his beloved sleep.*

J.C. McFERRA[N]. // Lt. Col. & Bvt. Brig. Gen. J.C. McFERRAN / U.S. Army / Born Oct. 18th 1820 / died April 25th 1872. // J.C. McFERRAN. // *Mark the perfect man, and behold / the upright; for the end of that / man is peace.* [large monument, covers entire grave]

GWINTHLEAN McFERRAN / Entered into / the light of endless day / January 9, 1895. [statue of angel writing in book]
