*Joseph Edward Willard's monument displays a famous 40-inch bronze bas-relief, entitled "Amor Caritas," by Augustus St. Gaudens, placed there in 1997, through the generosity of the Kermit Roosevelt family. The original relief was discovered stolen in December 1985 and ultimately recovered in 1986. Willard was our first ambassador to Spain, serving through World War I.

Unmarked Burial:

Willard, Joseph E., hotel keeper, son of Joseph Willard who started Willard Hotel in 1866
